

In order to graduate from Boston Prep, all students are required to complete:

- Four years of enrichment classes, including a Physical Fitness class
- Three approved summer enrichment programs, such as NYU Precollege, Harvard Medical School MEDscience program, MassArt Artward Bound program, or Boston SuccessLink.
