

SY25-26 Boston Prep Transportation Policy and Waiver

Boston Prep will be offering Local Motion yellow bus service for the 25-26 school year for those students who qualify. The priority of yellow bus seats will be issued to sixth grade students and students whose IEPs or 504s plan indicate door-door or corner stops. All students who are residents of the city of Boston in grades 7-12 will be issued a MBTA T-pass.

Yellow School Bus

To qualify your student must:

1. Be entering Grade 6
2. Student must live 1.5 miles from the school (885 River Street, Hyde Park, MA, 02136)
3. Student has to live in Boston

For incoming Grade 6 students ONLY

For Grades 7-12 ONLY

Waiver for Yellow Bus Transportation

Waiver Request Forms is used if your child is a **7-12th grade student** who is assigned a T Pass (M7/MBTA card), and you'd like to request Boston Prep's yellow bus service instead. PLEASE NOTE:

- These requests are **not** guaranteed approval and may be denied.
- These requests can only be made for Boston Prep students and will prioritize middle school students.
- These requests will only be approved if there is an existing corner stop in the area of the home and there is an available seat on the bus.
- If approved, the existing bus stop can be up to a mile away from the home address.
- If approved, the yellow bus services must be used every school day. (Student may not opt in for certain days like Monday and Tuesday.)
- If approved, your request **will not** carry over to the following school year and needs to be resubmitted as needed.
- If your child has a 504 or IEP plan and it is noted in the plan that they receive transportation, please do not fill this survey out.
- You will be placed on a waitlist until and if a seat becomes available.
